Reader's Guide

Methods Used to Conduct the Inventory

The inventory of parks and recreation assets has been updated from the previously created inventory by the Public Spaces Planning Unit and the Landscape Architecture Unit. Corrections and additions to the overall inventory were completed by Deputy Chief Parks Planner Juliana Fulton and her Strategic Plan Consultant Alex Spofford. Address corrections were completed by Archivist Andrea Gallucci. Updates on amenities and conditions of parks were completed by the respective landscape architect responsible for design and improvement of each park and overseen by Chief Landscape Architect Tim Karl. This process involved site visits to parks to confirm conditions. The recreation inventory involved the expertise of Assistant Director of Recreation John Armstrong for recreation centers, Strategic Partnerships Manager Maria Galarza for marinas, and Grounds lead Rosemary Edwards for cemeteries and golf courses. Conditions of recreation centers were provided by individual recreation center leaders and staff.

Park Typologies

As the parks and recreation system contains over 300 assets, the description of general purpose of each asset may be categorized by “type” as described in the PRSP, Chapter 1, page 15-24. In the following table, each asset is assigned a type that corresponds to these descriptions including specific recommended amenities and purpose.

Accessibility Assessment

Accessibility Grading System for Parks and Recreation Facilities:

Undeveloped = no amenities at the park

1 = None of the facilities meet accessibility guidelines

2 = Some facilities meet accessibility guidelines

3 = Most facilities meet accessibility guidelines

4 = The entire park meets accessibility guidelines

5 = The entire park was developed using the principles of universal design

Partnerships / Rec Facilities

GSD maintains partnership agreements with many non-profits and private organizations for the programming and upkeep of many public spaces across the city. These partners for parks and other outdoor public spaces include the organizations listed in the below table. GSD also partners to program some of its recreation centers including Clark (Clark Park Coalition), Considine (Historic Little Rock Family Life), Lipke (S.A.Y. Detroit Play), Palmer (People for Palmer Park), Tindall (Healthy Kidz Inc.), and Northwest Activities Center.

Role of Other Organizations Within Parks and Rec

Volunteers and other community organizations serve a vital role in the Detroit parks and recreation system. Community members provide many unrecorded benefits for parks, from helping keep an eye on the safety of a park to organizing large clean up events. They also play an important role in the decision making around parks by participating in and encouraging other local residents to volunteer their time and energy to meeting with us every time a park is improved.

The Adopt-A-Park program, which offers a more formal relationship for park volunteers, has recently been redefined and will be the pilot phase this year. This program requires park stewardship grounds to host two or more service days and two or more community events per year and offers formal recognition of the group as the park's official steward. This program transitions the emphasis from lawn mowing to beautification and community strengthening.

Park Stewards: Many of Detroit's larger regional parks have boards because they have established 501c3 status to fundraise for programming and other efforts. Each of these boards plays a major role in raising funds, making recommendations for improvements, and planning activities in parks. Additionally, the Detroit Parks Coalition, formed in 2018, brings together representatives from advocacy groups for many of Detroit's largest and most popular parks including the Belle Isle Conservancy, Chandler Park Conservancy, Clark Park Coalition, Detroit Riverfront Conservancy, Downtown Detroit Partnership, Friends of Patton Park, Friends of Rouge Park, Midtown Detroit, Inc., People for Palmer Park, and Sidewalk Detroit (Eliza Howell Park). Authority to make improvements and program activities ultimately lies with the General Services Department, as approved by City Council.
