Thank you for submitting an application for project review with the Historic District Commission for the project at 3844 Bagley in the Hubbard Farms Historic District. We would respectfully request some additional information.

1. We would request product information on all new materials being used at the exterior of the home. This could come in the form of product brochures, drawings, or similar documentation. This would include windows, doors, gutters, and siding, and any other new features.
2. It sounds like you are proposing to change some window openings. It would be helpful if you can produce some architectural drawings (can be hand drawn), or, at a minimum, annotated photographs showing which window openings are being removed.
3. If are planning any changes to the landscape (yard, fencing, etc), a site plan would also be required.
4. Please indicate what areas of the home are going to be painted in what color.

Thank you in advance. It is unlikely that this project will be able to be approved at the staff level, and will most likely need to be heard at a monthly Commission meeting. The next available Commission meeting takes place on April 17th. The deadline for completed applications to be heard at that meeting is March 25th.
