- 4 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Good afternoon,
- 5 ladies and gentlemen.
- 6 AUDIENCE: Good afternoon.
- 7 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you. Welcome
- 8 to the Board of Police Commissioners meeting. My name
- 9 is Jerome Warfield, Chairman of the Board of Police
- 10 Commissioners. Serving with me today is the Vice
- 11 Chairman of the Board of Police Commissioners,
- 12 Commissioner Adelia Rivera, as well as Commissioner
- 13 Reverend Michael Reeves and Commissioner Donnell White.
- 14 Sitting in for the chief today is Deputy Chief Tolbert.
- 15 Sir, good to have you.
- 16 DEPUTY CHIEF TOLBERT: Thank you, sir, good
- 17 to be here.
- 18 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: I'm going to ask if
- 19 our Secretary to the Board, Mr. George Anthony, will
- 20 introduce our staff?
- 21 SECRETARY ANTHONY: Thank you, Mr. Chair.
- 22 George Anthony, for the record. The introduction of
- our staff, Ms. Celia Banks-Washington, who is our
- 24 Attorney Supervising/Investigator, Ms. Dalph Watson,
- our Police Personnel Director, Ms. Tina Orr, who is our



- 1 Chief Investigator, Mr. Robert Brown, who is our office
- 2 manager standing in the back. I think Ms. Yolanda
- 3 Caudle who is a member of our staff. And I don't see
- 4 anyone else, Mr. Chair -- oh, and Officer Kent Cooper,
- 5 who is also assigned to our office. And I see we do
- 6 have Senior Investigator Melanie White from the Office
- 7 of Chief Investigator. That completes the
- 8 introductions.
- 9 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you,
- 10 Mr. Secretary.
- 11 SECRETARY ANTHONY: I apologize again.
- 12 Officer Terrence Bell who is recording our proceedings,
- 13 and Ms. Elizabeth Koller from Hanson Court Reporting
- 14 Services. I think that completes our introductions.
- 15 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you, sir, no
- 16 problem. At this time I'm going to ask if Chaplain
- 17 Dave Penson is here and if you can come to the podium?
- 18 Chaplain Penson is a member of Allen Temple AME Church
- 19 here in Detroit, Michigan. Sir, good to have you. I'm
- 20 going to ask you if you would lead us in our
- 21 invocation?
- 22 CHAPLAIN PENSON: Okay. Can we all bow our
- 23 heads in a word of prayer. Dear Heavenly Father in the
- 24 name of Jesus, we come before you just to say thank you
- 25 and ask your blessings upon this meeting that as we



- 1 begin to hear the echos of the community, God, to
- 2 enhance this community. And we just ask, God, that you
- 3 be with us. In Jesus' name, amen.
- 4 AUDIENCE: Amen.
- 5 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you, Chaplain
- 6 Penson. We appreciate you. At this time I'll
- 7 entertain a motion to approve the agenda for today's
- 8 meeting?
- 9 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: So moved.
- 10 COMMISSIONER REEVES: Second.
- 11 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: It's been properly
- 12 moved and second. All those in favor?
- 13 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
- 14 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: All those opposed?
- 15 Motion carries. I'll also entertain a motion to
- 16 approve the minutes from Thursday, January the 20th
- 17 meeting, 2011?
- 18 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: So moved.
- 19 COMMISSIONER REEVES: Second.
- 20 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: It's been properly
- 21 motioned and supported. All those in favor?
- 22 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
- 23 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: All those opposed?
- 24 Motion carries. Finally, we will approve the minutes
- 25 from Thursday, January the 27th meeting.



- 1 COMMISSIONER REEVES: So moved.
- 2 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: Second.
- 3 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: It's been properly
- 4 moved and second. All those in favor?
- 5 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
- 6 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: All those opposed?
- 7 Motion carries. There is no Chairperson Report at this
- 8 time. I'm going to yield the floor to Secretary George
- 9 Anthony and he will walk us through some procedures.
- 10 SECRETARY ANTHONY: Thank you, Mr. Chair.
- 11 George Anthony, again, for the record. We have two
- 12 petitions for you to consider. They were suspensions
- 13 without pay. One deals with Officer Randal Overton,
- 14 and the second deals with Police Officer Brian James.
- 15 I would like to discuss the one that deals
- 16 with Officer Overton. This is a stipulation to
- 17 allegations that are set forth in the department's
- 18 petition to suspend without pay Police Officer Randal
- 19 Overton under Article 9. Officer Overton's Badge
- 20 Number is 179.
- It is hereby stipulated by John J. Goldpaugh
- 22 of Goldpaugh and Associates, PC, on behalf of Officer
- 23 Overton that the allegations set forth in the petition
- 24 to suspend Police Officer Randal Overton without pay
- 25 including but not limited to the fact that 33rd



- 1 District Court Felony Warrant Number 10-13582 has been
- 2 issued against Officer Overton and the fact that he is
- 3 presently scheduled for a preliminary examination on
- 4 February 8th, 2011, on those charges, are sufficient to
- 5 concur with Chief Ralph L. Godbee, Junior's, request
- 6 that Officer Overton be suspended without pay effective
- 7 February 3rd, 2011 pursuant to Article 9 of the
- 8 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of
- 9 Detroit and the Detroit Police Officer's Association.
- 10 Respectfully submitted Goldpaugh and Associates, John
- 11 Goldpaugh, February 3th, 2011.
- 12 This is a fax transmittal sheet that
- 13 accompanied the stipulation. It reads this stipulation
- 14 shall also act as a withdrawal of our request for a
- 15 closed door session with respect to Officer Overton
- 16 only. The suspension without pay is a recommendation
- 17 from the chief, Chief Godbee. Looking at the
- 18 stipulation there appears to be no objection and unless
- 19 contravened by the Board of Police Commissioners the
- 20 suspension without pay will stand.
- 21 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Just for clarity
- 22 purposes for the record's sake Mr. Goldpaugh is the
- 23 attorney for Officer Overton and he agrees with
- 24 Chief Godbee that Officer Overton should be suspended
- 25 without pay?



- 1 SECRETARY ANTONY: That's correct.
- 2 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Seeing as though that
- 3 there is no contravention, suspension without pay
- 4 remains or shall be enforced. Thank you.
- 5 SECRETARY ANTHONY: Thank you. The second --
- 6 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: Excuse me. For the
- 7 record, can you put down the day that -- is this the
- 8 one that we're not going to vote on for two weeks?
- 9 SECRETARY ANTHONY: No, no, no.
- 10 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: Okay. Never mind.
- 11 Withdrawn.
- 12 SECRETARY ANTHONY: The second matter that
- 13 has come before the Board was a request for a closed
- 14 door session under the open meeting act for Police
- 15 Officer Brian James, Badge Number 2227, also
- 16 represented by Attorney John J. Goldpaugh. We received
- 17 a call from Mr. Goldpaugh today that there is a
- 18 pressing family matter that he has to attend to and
- 19 that he would not be able to attend a closed door
- 20 session.
- 21 He has asked the Board if they would kindly
- 22 put off this matter for two weeks and that it can be
- 23 properly heard in closed door and has also indicated
- 24 that whatever the Board decides in two weeks would be
- 25 effective as of today's date, February 3rd, 2011.



- 1 So I leave that to the Board's discretion
- 2 with regards to postponing that matter.
- 3 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Is there a motion
- 4 concerning Officer Brian James?
- 5 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: Moved to postpone it
- for a vote for two weeks.
- 7 COMMISSIONER WHITE: Support.
- 8 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: It's been properly
- 9 moved and supported. Any discussion? Hearing or
- 10 seeing none, all those in favor of postponing please
- 11 say aye?
- 12 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
- 13 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: All those opposed?
- 14 Motion carries. Thank you, sir.
- 15 SECRETARY ANTHONY: Thank you.
- 16 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Is there anything
- 17 else?
- 18 SECRETARY ANTHONY: No, there isn't.
- 19 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you.
- 20 Mr. Deputy Chief, anything from the department?
- DEPUTY CHIEF TOLBERT: Nothing, sir.
- 22 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Okay. Thank you. At
- 23 this time I want to make an announcement that our next
- 24 meeting will be held Thursday, February the 10th, 6:30
- 25 p.m. It's a community meeting. So it will be held at



- 1 6:30 p.m., in the Eastern District at Wow Church,
- 2 W-O-W, Wow Church and Life Center which is located at
- 3 14111 East Seven Mile Road, Detroit, Michigan. So
- 4 please, ma'am, please, sir, mark your calendars for
- 5 that.
- At this time we will entertain communications
- 7 from the audience. If you wish to address the Board of
- 8 Police Commissioners, please come to the mic, to the
- 9 podium, I'm sorry, state your name for the record and
- 10 we ask that you abide by our four-minute time limit,
- 11 that will give all of our citizens an opportunity to
- 12 speak.
- MS. MORRIS: Good afternoon.
- 14 COMMISSIONERS: Good afternoon.
- MS. MORRIS: Tijuana Morris with Fight for
- 16 your Rights Investigation and retired police officer,
- 17 also the investigator for the Detroit Coalition Against
- 18 Police Brutality. Two questions -- well, one question,
- 19 statement. If a citizen wanted to find out what
- 20 charges were brought against an officer at this hearing
- 21 or at this meeting, at the public meeting, how would
- 22 they go about it? Can they FOIA request the
- 23 information?
- 24 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: I'm sorry?
- MS. MORRIS: To find out what the



- 1 stipulations were concerning any officer, not just this
- 2 particular, but any disciplinary actions? In the old
- 3 days they used to say it here in the meetings. But is
- 4 there another way if they wanted to?
- 5 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Absolutely, you
- 6 certainly can certainly FOIA the request. Let me say
- 7 this because I'm glad you brought that point up --
- 8 MS. MORRIS: Thank you.
- 9 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: -- for the sake of
- 10 transparency, the issues were so sensitive and delicate
- 11 that the Board and the attorneys thought it would be
- 12 best that they not be mentioned verbally. It was just
- 13 that sensitive. However, but they are available as
- 14 FOIA.
- 15 MS. MORRIS: Secondly, my comment that
- 16 everyone knows that I'm out there on the street if
- 17 something's wrong. I do see some progression in the
- 18 Detroit Police Department and some transparencies. And
- 19 even the growth of the 300 Club coming out. And if the
- 20 Detroit Coalition had any part in anybody's thinking of
- 21 joining I appreciate it.
- There is a situation that I'm looking into
- 23 that is sensitive and it's due to police credibility.
- 24 And as always this Board knows that I will come back
- and voice and let them know what's happening in the



- 1 street.
- 2 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you. And,
- 3 Sister Morris, while you're there, certainly if there's
- 4 anything you want to share with us privately you know
- 5 we're open to hear that from you.
- 6 MS. MORRIS: Yeah, and as always it's for the
- 7 safety of our city as well as for our officers. Thank
- 8 you.
- 9 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Yes, ma'am, Attorney
- 10 Washington?
- 11 ATTORNEY WASHINGTON: Celia Washington, for
- 12 the record. Just as a point of clarification with
- 13 regard to Ms. Morris' last concern, I wanted to make
- 14 sure that we were clear at what point in the
- 15 investigation is that information FOIA-ible. And I
- 16 confirmed with the law department that that information
- 17 is not FOIA-ible, if there is such a word, until the
- 18 conclusion. So we're talking after the trial board,
- 19 after the process had been completed. Anything in the
- 20 interim is not available to the public.
- 21 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you, ma'am, for
- 22 that clarification.
- 23 ELDER DAVIS: Good afternoon.
- 24 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Good afternoon, sir.
- 25 ELDER DAVIS: To the Deputy Chief, to the



- 1 Police Board of Commissioners. My name is Elder
- 2 Anthony Davis, Senior, from AC Towing. From our last
- 3 meeting, Commissioner White said if we want him to
- 4 invite him to come to our tow operation and see us,
- 5 our daily basis I'm inviting him to AC Towing. And our
- 6 telephone number is (313) 895-9595. My name is Elder
- 7 Anthony Davis, Senior. My wife, Christine Davis. You
- 8 can call us and we can set up a date and you can see
- 9 how our operation goes.
- 10 COMMISSIONER WHITE: Mr. Davis, I appreciate
- 11 the invitation. If I could ask if you would work with
- 12 Brother Brown. He'll get you a schedule for the week
- 13 of what would be convenient.
- 14 ELDER DAVIS: Thank you, sir.
- 15 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you, Elder
- 16 Davis. Anymore comments for the Board? Questions?
- 17 Comments for the Board? Hearing and seeing none we
- 18 will close that portion of our meeting. Thank you,
- 19 ladies and gentlemen.
- Commissioner White, did you have something?
- 21 COMMISSIONER WHITE: Just as a point of
- 22 clarification were we expecting, through the chair, to
- 23 DC Tolbert, was this the meeting we were supposed to be
- 24 prepared to have the report back on the towing rules
- 25 and regulations?



- 1 DEPUTY CHIEF TOLBERT: That is correct, sir,
- 2 and I have it here. This is a proposed draft that I
- 3 presented to the chief just before he left. So he
- 4 hasn't had a chance to review this towing draft. I
- 5 want to stress that this is a draft and there might
- 6 still be some additional changes.
- 7 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Okay.
- 8 DEPUTY CHIEF TOLBERT: But this is a
- 9 culmination of having all the abandoned vehicle
- 10 officers in the department get together and look at the
- 11 process. This will address some of the issues as far
- 12 as recovering stolen vehicles and aban vehicles.
- 13 Your question as to, and I'm going to defer
- 14 it to DC Lee, your question as to why things were the
- 15 way they are, now I couldn't answer, and I'm not going
- 16 to try that again. But I'll pass these down to every
- 17 commissioner so you can look at that at your leisure
- 18 and if you have any questions.
- 19 This will eliminate the east tow issue with
- 20 the recovery of stolen vehicles and this will also
- 21 standardize the aban and stolen vehicle process
- 22 throughout the department once it's approved and
- 23 implemented. So as promised.
- 24 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you, sir. That
- answers your question, Commissioner?



- 1 COMMISSIONER WHITE: Yes, sir.
- 2 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Commissioner Rivera?
- 3 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: Also for the record let
- 4 me state that while I was in Mexico I understand my
- 5 request for the amount of tows by which companies and
- 6 the abandoned tows was submitted. I will look it over
- 7 and have a report on it.
- 8 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Thank you,
- 9 Commissioner.
- 10 COMMISSIONER RIVERA: Thank you, Commander
- 11 Lee and Chief for getting that to me.
- 12 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Do you have
- 13 something, Deputy Chief?
- DEPUTY CHIEF LEE: No, sir.
- 15 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: Do you have anything
- 16 else? All right. At this time I'll have a motion to
- 17 adjourn the meeting for today?
- 18 COMMISSIONER REEVES: So moved.
- 19 COMMISSIONER WHITE: Second.
- 20 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: It's been properly
- 21 moved and second that the meeting be adjourned. All
- 22 those in favor?
- 23 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
- 24 COMMISSIONER WARFIELD: All those opposed?
- 25 Motion carries. Thank you, ladies and gentlemen.
