5	take over the towing?
6	Do you have any update on anything
7	regarding that?
8	COMMISSIONER TAYLOR: No, we don't at
9	this time, we don't have anything.
10	MS. DAVIS: Okay.
11	COMMISSIONER TAYLOR: And all that will
12	be coming from the Purchasing Department.
13	MS. DAVIS: Okay. Does the Purchasing
14	meet with you and let you know what's going on?
15	I mean, my issue is that there's a lack of
16	communication among the persons on the Police
17	Board of Commissioners, the Mayor, the people
18	right here in the city. There's a lack of
19	communication. Before outsiders come in, don't
20	you think that we together would try to come to
21	come kind of agreement to make "I believe in
22	Detroit." That's what the Mayor said. He's
23	interested in small businesses, so at some point
24	somebody should meet with us, you know, one on
25	one before they let San Francisco or somebody or

2	but any other company come into Detroit because
3	we are sufficient, we can do it, we can do it. I
4	believe in Detroit. I believe in the towing
5	business and any other businesses here in
6	Detroit.

9	appreciate the fact that the Board of Police
10	Commissioners takes time to listen to us, to
11	communicate, and you guys do communicate with us
12	and I appreciate that.
13	You're the only link that we really
14	have to come before you and I appreciate that.
15	COMMISSIONER TAYLOR: Thank you, ma'am.
16	Commissioner White?
17	COMMISSIONER WHITE: Ms. Davis, before
18	you leave just for the record and for the benefit
19	of everyone, this body did submit requested a
20	legal opinion from the City's counsel department
21	in terms of what authority the Board has and what
22	authority they have in terms of where they are
23	with this towing process.

the City's purview to do what they are doing, so
