**SUBJECT:** Lead-Based Paint Hazard and Dust-Lead Clearance Level Changes

Taking effect January 6, 2020, lead-based paint hazard and dust-lead clearance levels will change in Michigan. These changes stem from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) lowering their dust level standards for lead-based paint hazards.

Surface Area	Hazard and Clearance Level	Lead-Based Paint Hazard Level	Dust-Lead Clearance Level
Interior Floors	40 micrograms per square foot (µg/ft2)	$\geq$ 10 µg/ft2	< 10 µg/ft2
Porch Floors	No Sample Required	$\ge$ 40 ug/ft2	< 40 ug/ft2
Window Sills	250 µg/ft2	$\geq$ 100 µg/ft2	< 100 µg/ft2
Window Troughs	400 µg/ft2	$\geq$ 100 µg/ft2	< 100 µg/ft2
