

Future Transit Center Location

The Detroit Department of Transportation (DDOT) completed the equity analysis and community engagement for DDOT's new Transit Center and finalized the location.

After analyzing options and reviewing feedback, DDOT decided on the city-owned property located off of 8 Mile and East of the Gateway Shopping Plaza as shown above.

The State Fairgrounds at Woodward and 8 Mile Road provide transit riders access to over a dozen existing transit routes, including DDOT and SMART service and other regional access. Additionally, the city-owned property provides DDOT the opportunity to build a state-of-the-art facility in conjunction with other city departments such as Department of Public Works (DPW) to ensure the accessibility and facility are meeting rider and partner needs. The selected location also provides direct access to area destinations and provides the opportunity for additional mobility improvements in the area.

For the next steps, DDOT will continue to work with other City departments involved in this development, including the Detroit Building Authority (DBA), DPW, and other mobility partners such as SMART, MoGo, and more.

DDOT will continue to include our riders' and partners' input throughout this process. DDOT will post updates and lead community engagement until the site completion, expected in 2022.
