# 36th District Drug Treatment Court

- ▶ **Mission: to reduce the use and abuse of drugs and/or alcohol, and to reduce recidivism in the drug related criminal activity.**
- ▶ **Purpose: herein DTC was developed to reduce criminal recidivism among non-violent misdemeanor offenders by eliminating their reliance on mood-altering substances.**
  - ▶ **The DTC Program is designed to hold offenders accountable for their behavior while providing them rehabilitative services necessary to maintain a drug free, law-abiding lifestyle.**

# 36th District Drug Treatment Court

## INCENTIVES AND SANCTIONS

Responses to behaviors will be individualized and will occur immediately after the behavior. Examples of incentives and sanctions may include:

Restricted license	No applause
Praise by the Judge	Community service

Leave court session early	Termination from the program

# Types of Problem-Solving Courts

---

- 207 PSCs total in Michigan
- 137 drug treatment, DWI/sobriety courts:
  - 58 hybrid (DWI/drug) treatment courts
  - 38 DWI sobriety courts
  - 13 adult drug treatment courts
  - 11 juvenile drug treatment courts
  - 8 family treatment courts
  - 9 tribal Healing-to-Wellness Courts
- 42 mental health courts
  - 35 adult MHCs
  - 7 juvenile MHCs
- 28 veterans treatment courts



# Target Population & Eligibility

---

So who belongs in a drug court?

- People who are assessed as having a high risk level of re-offending/failing probation AND as in need of high level of treatment

So who doesn't belong in a drug court?

- People who can more easily complete probation services (low risk to re-offend) or who are not in need of intensive treatment

So how do we know who is who?

- Assessments!
