COVID-19 CASE RATE

The 7-day average rate of new confirmed COVID-19 cases among City of Detroit residents is 16.4 daily cases per million people as of 04/08/2024. This has increased compared to the previous report, when it was reported as 13.8 cases per million people.




Figure 1: COVID-19 confirmed (daily/1,000,000) cases

COVID-19 HOSPITAL ADMISSIONS

The current COVID-19 hospital admissions level for Detroit, Wayne County is Low at 2.3 new COVID-19 hospital admissions per 100,000 population (7-day total).

There are currently 10 COVID-19 occupied inpatient beds and 3 COVID-19 occupied ICU beds recorded in the city of Detroit.





Figure 3: COVID-19 hospital occupancy

COVID-19 WASTEWATER MONITORING

Wastewater monitoring shows 14% of sampling sites have detectable levels and 0% of sites have high levels of SARS-CoV-2 markers as of 04/16/2024 in the city of Detroit.

 The proportions are out of 22 sites across the city of Detroit from which wastewater samples are taken and tested for SARS-CoV-2 markers. Each sampling site represents a specific population based on the area its sewer shed covers, such as long-term care facilities, college dormitories, and entire ZIP code areas. Detectable levels are over 1000 copies/100mL; high levels are over 5000 copies/100mL.
