City of Detroit Wrecking License Information

Only properly completed applications will be accepted for processing. All required **application forms** and **supporting documentation** must be submitted **14 days** prior to any scheduled Board meeting. You will be advised, by email, of your application status/acceptance and the time, date and location of the scheduled Wrecking Board hearing. The Qualifying Officer shall be required to appear before the Board in person or virtually. The following list is provided to help you complete your application correctly.

- 1. Be sure to have your application *SIGNED* and *NOTARIZED*.
- 2. If operating as a partnership, you will be required to provide a certified copy of the **Copartnership Certificate** you registered at the Wayne County Clerk's office. The Qualifying Officer/Applicant is required to be a partner/officer of the corporation.
- 3. If you will be operating as a corporation, you must provide us with a copy of your **Articles of Incorporation** and your most recent annual report. The Qualifying Officer/Applicant is required to be a partner/officer of the corporation.
- 4. A Minimum of three (3) years supervisory experience (**Foreman-Superintendent-Supervisor**) is mandatory to qualify for a wrecking license in the City of Detroit unless the application is for a Class C License. <u>NOTE</u>: All employers listed on your application are required to provide us with an **Employment Affidavit**. We recommend that you mail or deliver copies of the sample affidavit to each of your former employers.
- 5. If you were **self-employed** and operating your own company, you shall provide evidence of experience by submitting the following:
 - **a**) Copies of **issued wrecking permits** and **pictures** listing your company as the prime contractor.
 - **b)** Affidavits from clients or customers whose building you have demolished. We will not accept testimonial letters of character.
 - c) Copies of Workman's Compensation audits submitted by your firm.

Instructions for Submitting the Wrecking License Application

- **I.** Submit a *Certificate of Liability and Surety Bond* to the **Law Department, Room 500** for review using the following link: https://bit.ly/2AOmQY0
- II. Submit a completed Wrecking Contractor License/Registration package to the Construction Inspection Division, Room 408. The package shall include:
 - State of Michigan *Builders' License* or *Residential Maintenance & Alterations License* with "*House Wrecking*" Classification.
 - Wrecking License application (available online).
 - Bond approval letter from the **Business License Center Division**
 - A front and back copy of the driver's license of the state license holder.
 - A recent passport type photograph of the applicant.
 - Permits with photos as evidence of experience in demolition
- III. The Qualifying Officer/Applicant for a new Wrecking License, who is required to be a partner/officer of the corporation, must first submit a complete Wrecking License package (*including the bond approval letter*) to the Construction Division for processing. The completed Wrecking License package will then be forwarded to the Board of Wrecking Contractors Examiners for an oral interview. The fee for the initial review before the Wrecking Board of Examiners is \$329.00. Upon approval by the Board of Wrecking Contractors Examiners, the applicant will be required to pay a fee of \$86.00 for a written exam. After payment an examination date shall be scheduled. A passing grade of 75% on the written exam will award the applicant with a City of Detroit Wrecking License. The fee to obtain the Wrecking License is \$302.00. - **IV.** The Qualifying Officer/Applicant renewing a Wrecking License will submit a completed registration form requesting renewal of an existing license to the Construction Inspection Division for review. All applicants once approved and after processing must pay a renewal fee of \$302.00 to the License & Permits Division.
- **V.** All Wrecking Licenses expires December 31st of each year without exceptions.



Wrecking License Requirements Information Details

- 1. Wrecking operations are governed by Michigan Building Code Chapter 33, Section 3303, and City of Detroit Code of Ordinances, Article II Building Code, sections 8-2-1, 8-8-2-12, & 8-2-19. BOCA Chapter 33, Section 3304.0, 3310.0, Ordinance 290-H, Sections 12-11-19 through 12-11-20.10., 15-98, & 17-98.
- 2. The Qualifying Officer/Applicant for a Wrecking License must be approved by the Board of Wrecking Contractors Examiners and have a minimum experience of three (3) years as a Supervisor engaged in demolition. The Qualifying Officer/Applicant who possesses a degree or registration as an architect or civil engineer who has proven experience of up to two (2) years may be extended to anyone.
- 3. The Board of Examiners for Wrecking Contractors usually meets on the third Wednesday of alternate months beginning in February. However, a special session can be called when necessary.

Wrecking License Class Divisions

The City of Detroit has three types wrecking licenses available

Class A Restricted – Contractor permitted to wreck only commercial structures.

**Class A Unrestricted – Contractor permitted to wreck commercial and residential structures above 35ft in height.

Class B Restricted – Contractor permitted to wreck commercial structures not exceeding 3 stories or 35ft in height.

**Class B Unrestricted – Contractor permitted to wreck commercial and residential structures not exceeding 3 stories or 35ft in height. Must possess a valid residential buildings state license.

**Class C – Contractor permitted to wreck residential structures only. It allows the potential licensee to apply for the license after showing experience in wrecking of (5) five residential structures. The (3) three-year requirement has been removed, providing a shorter window for getting into the wrecking business in the City of Detroit.

**Michigan Residential Builders or Maintenance and Alteration Contractors License is required.

If you hold a current Michigan Builders or Alterations Contractors' License (Wrecking). Please submit a copy of the wall certificate or degree with this application. A POCKET CERTIFICATE IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.
