DWSD Responding to Sinkhole on Tireman at Greenfield

The Detroit Water & Sewerage Department (DWSD) is responding to a sinkhole on Tireman west of Greenfield. The sinkhole is the result of a collapsed sewer pipe. DWSD crews are on the scene. Beyond the street closure, there are no reports that homes and businesses are affected.

SEWER PIPE REPAIR OVERVIEW:

- **Location:** Tireman eastbound, west of Greenfield
- **Time reported:** 12:40 p.m.
- **DWSD initial response:** 1:20 p.m.
- **Initial status:** DWSD responded with an investigator who has dispatched a team to identify the cause of the collapse. Once the cause is determined, repairs will begin. The estimated time of repair is unknown.

There is no reason at this time to believe that water quality is diminished in the area.
