## Ice Cream Truck / Vegetable-Fruit Truck Inspections

You need:

- 1.) A money order for \$225.00 for Packaged Ice Cream trucks/units. A money order for \$75.00 for fruit and vegetable trucks
- 2.) An ice cream truck or a vegetable truck (commercial trucks only)
- 3.) Your driver's license
- 4.) The vehicle registration for the truck
- 5.) A contract with the owner of the truck, if you are leasing it.

## Tips for Passing Truck inspection:

- 1. Come to the inspection with a clean truck.
- 2. Make sure your truck works and can pass a vehicle maintenance inspection. (Only commercial vehicles are allowed)
- 3. Make sure all lights and signs work.
- 4. Make sure you have provided the safety features in Section 55-11-3 of the Detroit Traffic and Motor Vehicle Ordinance. Please ask for a copy.
- 5. Make sure screens and windows are in good condition.
- 6. Have an approved sanitizer solution in a spray bottle and wiping clothes and test strip to test the concentration. (Clorox unscented wipes is a goal alternative)
- 7. Make sure your business name and phone number is on both sides of the truck and the letters and numbers are at least 3 inches tall.
- 8. Make sure your freezer is clean and in good repair.
- 9. Have handy wipes or sanitizer for cleaning your hands.
- 10. Do not have carpet in your truck
- 11. Make sure your truck is smooth and easily cleanable and does not have holes and rust on the floor, walls, and ceiling.
- 12. Make sure that an average height person can stand-up in the vehicle. (This should not be a problem if the truck is a commercial vehicle.)
