Appeals Hearing

The Detroit City Council will conduct an Appeals Hearing on the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Neighborhood Opportunity Fund (NOF) program recommendations on Monday, April 11, 2016 at 3:30 PM. The Appeals Hearing will be held in the Auditorium on the 13th Floor of the Coleman A. Young Municipal Center. Registration will begin at 3:00 PM.

The Appeals Hearing is a formal opportunity for appeals to be made exclusively by those organizations that were NOT recommended funding for ANY proposal submitted by that organization.

Appeals are to be made in writing using the enclosed form. The form is to be submitted on the day of the Appeals Hearing at the registration table which will be set up outside of the Auditorium. Please retain a copy of the form for your records. By April 6th, the recommendations will be posted on-line at www.detroitmi.gov/ - select the City Departments link, go to City Planning Commission, and click on Community Development Block Grant link.

Public Hearing

The Detroit City Council will host a Public Hearing on the CDBG and NOF program on Tuesday, April 12, 2016 at 2:00 PM. An overview of the 2016-17 CDBG/NOF will be provided at the beginning of the hearing. Registration will begin at 1:30 PM. A registration Table will be set up outside of the auditorium

The public hearing will be open to all 2016-17 CDBG/NOF applicants to allow for comments on the overall CDBG budget and individual concerns. **No appeals will be taken on this day.** The public hearing will be held in the Auditorium on the 13th Floor of the Coleman A. Young Municipal Center.
