**NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR 2015-2016 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
NEIGHBORHOOD OPPORTUNITY FUND (NOF) PROPOSALS,
CDBG/NOF WORKSHOPS**

The City of Detroit invites community organizations to submit proposals for projects to be funded by the 2015-2016 Community Development Block Grant/Neighborhood Opportunity Fund (CDBG/NOF) program.

CDBG/NOF workshop applications will be issued for the following four activities only:

- Public Service
- Homeless Public Service
- Public Facility Rehabilitation
- Commercial Façade Improvements

All community organizations including neighborhood residents, business organizations, block clubs, human service organizations, etc. who wish to participate in the development and implementation of **either CDBG or NOF projects** as advisors and/or as operating agencies may submit proposals.

All Proposals for the 2015-2016 CDBG/NOF Program must be submitted on a 2015-2016 CDBG/NOF Proposal Form. It must be complete, and **must be received at the Detroit Housing and Revitalization Department (formerly the Planning and Development Department) 2 Woodward Avenue, Suite 908, Detroit, MI, before 3:30 PM, Wednesday, April 6, 2015.** Fax Copies of Proposals will not be accepted.

Proposals submitted by the April 6, 2015 deadline will be evaluated by city agencies and designated partners. Funding approval, for proposals, will be determined by the Mayor and City Council.

The 2015-2016 CDBG/NOF proposal packages with the proposal forms will be available March 11, 2015 at Housing and Revitalization Department (HRD)/City Planning Commission workshops.
