Sugar Hill Arts District

The City of Detroit is seeking proposals from qualified entities for the purpose of developing a multi-family rental housing project with street level retail and structured parking located in the Sugar Hill Arts District of Midtown. The property is currently vacant and includes the following parcels: 81, 95, 107, and 119 Garfield Street (the "Property"). The Property is approximately 0.79 acres and is generally bound by East Forest, John R, Garfield, and Woodard. The City is requesting development of at least 60 residential units, 7,000 square feet of ground-floor retail, and construction of a parking structure for 260 vehicles.
