## NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #600500

The City of Detroit, Housing and Revitalization Department (H&RD), Housing Services Division, is requesting proposals for Administrator, Loan Servicing Contractor to manage the collection of loan repayments for its HOME Investor Loan, Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP), and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Rehabilitation Loan Programs in compliance with HUD federal requirements. This will be a three (3) year contract term for services.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

H&RD seeks competitive proposals from qualified firms. Firms must provide evidence of experience, technical knowledge and a description of the firm's capabilities to perform the services required to service the aforementioned HUD funded programs. The selected firm will assume loan servicing of the City of Detroit's current loan portfolio. The firm will accept and review loan documents for new loan servicing. The Firm will also collect deposits of all loan payments consistent with loan closing documents and scheduled payment notes, deposit revenue into an established City account.
