NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Detroit Department of Transportation (DDOT) will be holding public hearings to present upcoming service changes planned for April and June 2009.

Proposed April 2009 Service Changes are: (1) The elimination of Express Routes #70-Crosstown, #71-Grand River, #72-Dexter, #73-Woodward, and #74 Gratiot due to their failure to meet DDOT's service standards during the trial period and beyond; and, (2) A change in the frequency of service on the #8 Caniff route.

Route 8 Caniff

The proposed changes to the #8 Caniff route, are as follows: The wait time between buses for a.m. and p.m. peak service hours will be increased from 45 minutes to 60 minutes. Also, the travel time for trips between Webb/LaSalle and French Rd. /Gratiot will be reduced by 8 minutes in each direction.

The proposed June 2009 service changes are adjustments to all routes that travel to downtown Detroit. Routes currently serving Capitol Park and routes operating along Woodward will be redirected to serve the **Rosa Parks Transit Center, which is located at 360 Michigan Avenue**, and are as follows:
