Effective June 20, 2009

Route 18 Fenkell
Northbound travel time will increase by two (2) minutes. Southbound travel time will increase by three (3) minutes.

Route 21 Grand River
Service between buses will increase from ten (10) minutes to twelve (12) minutes between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., and 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Eastbound travel time will decrease by three (3) minutes. Westbound travel time will decrease by four (4) minutes between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., and increase by two (2) minutes between 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Route 23 Hamilton
Southbound travel time will increase by two (2) minutes.

Route 25 Jefferson
Westbound travel time will increase by one (1) minute.

Route 27 Joy Road
Eastbound travel time will increase by (3) minutes. Westbound travel time will increase by five (5) minutes.

Route 32 McNichols
Eastbound travel time will decrease by six (6) minutes. Westbound travel time will increase by eleven (11) minutes.

Route 34 Gratiot
Eastbound travel time will increase by three (3) minutes between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Westbound travel time will decrease by four (4) minutes.

Route 36 Oakland
Northbound travel time will increase by one (1) minute. Southbound travel time will increase by two (2) minutes.

Route 38 Plymouth
Eastbound travel time will decrease by five (5) minutes. Westbound travel time will decrease by two (2) minutes.

Route 40 Russell
Northbound and southbound travel time will increase by one (1) minute.

Route 45 Seven Mile
Service between buses will increase from ten (10) minutes to fifteen (15) minutes from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m., and 2:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. Eastbound travel will increase by one (1) minute.

Route 47 Tireman
Eastbound travel time will increase by three (3) minutes. Westbound travel time will decrease by one (1) minute.

Route 48 Van Dyke
Northbound travel time will increase by two (2) minutes. Southbound travel time will increase by one (1) minute.

Route 49 Vernor
Eastbound and westbound travel time will increase by two (2) minutes.

Route 53 Woodward
Northbound and southbound travel time will increase by two (2) minutes.

EFFECTIVE JULY 14, 2009

Effective **July 14, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.**, the Rosa Parks Transit Center will open to the public. Bus routes that currently end at Capitol Park and Grand Circus Park will end at the new transit center.

There are 15 bus bays at the Rosa Parks Transit Center (RPTC). Each bus route has been assigned a specific bus bay (except #38 Plymouth, #47 Tireman, and #76 Hayes Ltd.) for passenger boarding.
