Electors who registered, voted or transferred in Detroit since January 1, 1998 are not required to register. Those who have moved from one Detroit address to another since they last voted may transfer at the Department of Elections in person, or by mailing a signed notice no later than Monday, February 8, 2016, giving old and new addresses.

Persons who registered prior to January 1, 1998 but have not voted since, should re-register, if they have not already done so.
