**BACKGROUND**

The HUD Consolidated Plan is a five year strategic plan, updated every year, describing the needs, conditions, objectives, priorities, strategies, and action programs related to community development, affordable housing, the homeless, and housing for persons with special needs, including persons living with HIV and AIDS. The plan is required so the City may receive funds from certain HUD programs. The plan contains the annual funding applications for the following HUD programs:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- HOME Investment Partnership (HOME)
- Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG)
- Housing Opportunities For Persons With Aids (HOPWA)

The City is currently preparing the 2010-2011 Action Plan updates. During the public hearing, the Planning and Development Department will describe the contents of past plans, types of activities that may be undertaken using 2010-2011 funds from the various programs, and the funding process. Participants at the hearings will be given an opportunity to ask questions and to present their opinions regarding the consolidated plan process and proposed activities to include in the plan. The hearings will focus on these matters, and are not being held to discuss funding for particular organizations.
