- CREATE a shared vision for the future that brings together residents, businesses, developers, and City government.



Support current residents and long-time homeowners! Strengthen neighborhoods by connecting residents with the resources they need most.





Make creative investments in vacant school sites so they can continue to serve the community in the future. And, support active schools too!





This area needs more businesses that serve residents—especially along Warren Ave and near the Greenway. Priorities include food options and community spaces.






Industrial development needs to keep their sites clean and not pollute the environment. Hiring locals and contributing to the local economy is important too.





Activate open space in neighborhoods. More residents prefer new infill housing and permanent community spaces, rather than informal landscapes.






First, fix broken sidewalks, potholes, and areas that flood. Then, focus on safe connections to the Greenway.

We'll do a group role-playing exercise to share what our future neighborhood is like. Facilitators will guide you through this part.




Look at the dot on the **FRONT** of your activity booklet.
