OCI MISSION STATEMENT

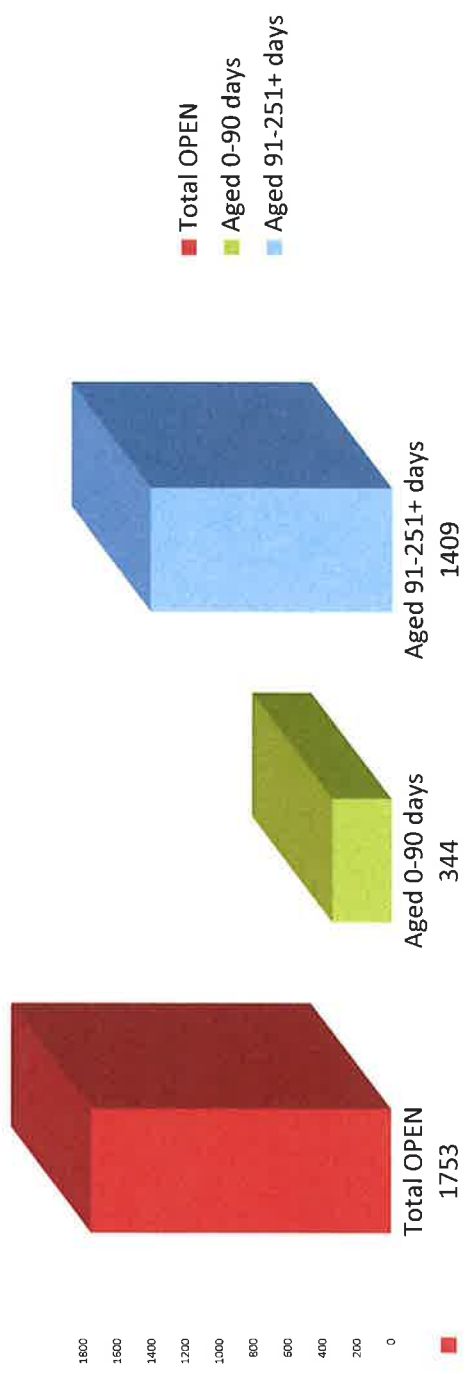

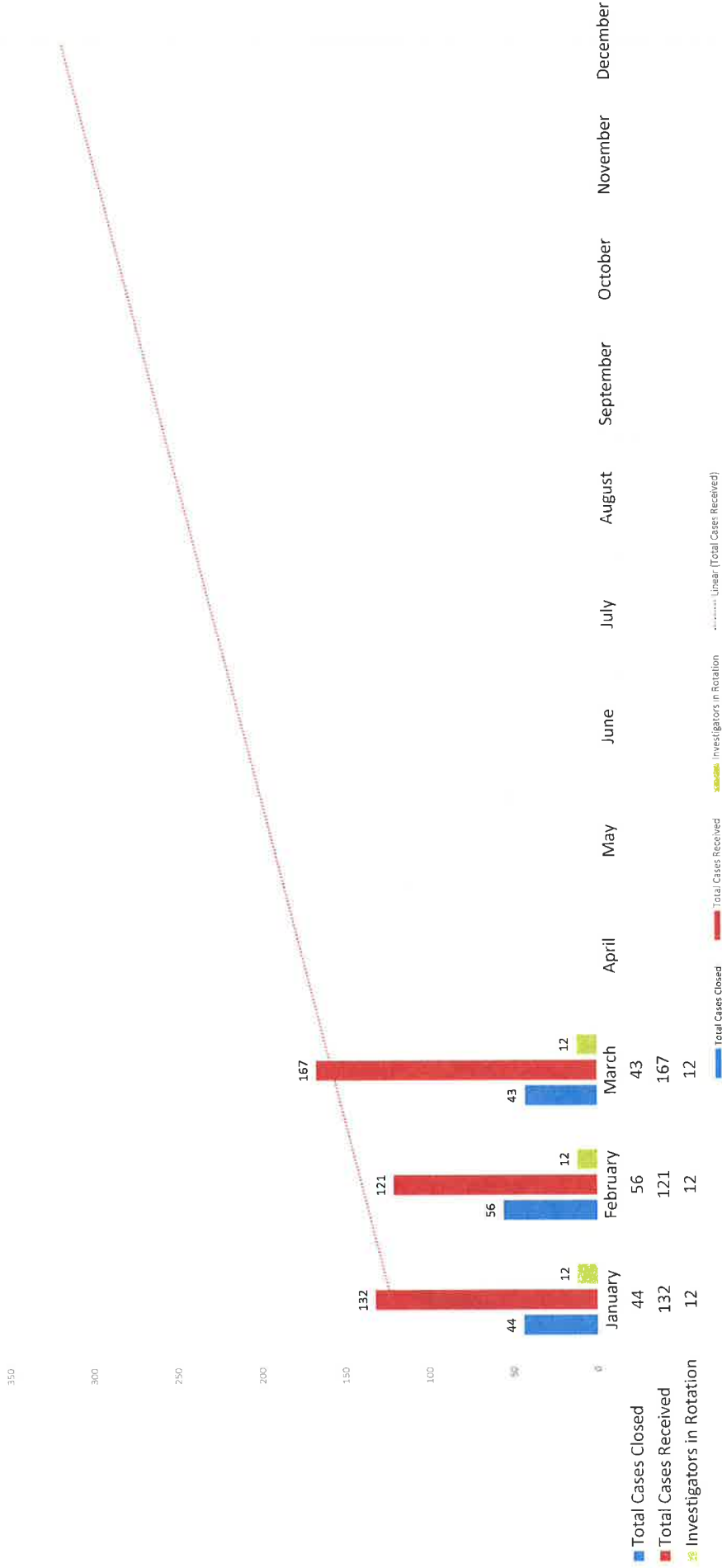


OPEN CASES AS OF MARCH 31, 2024

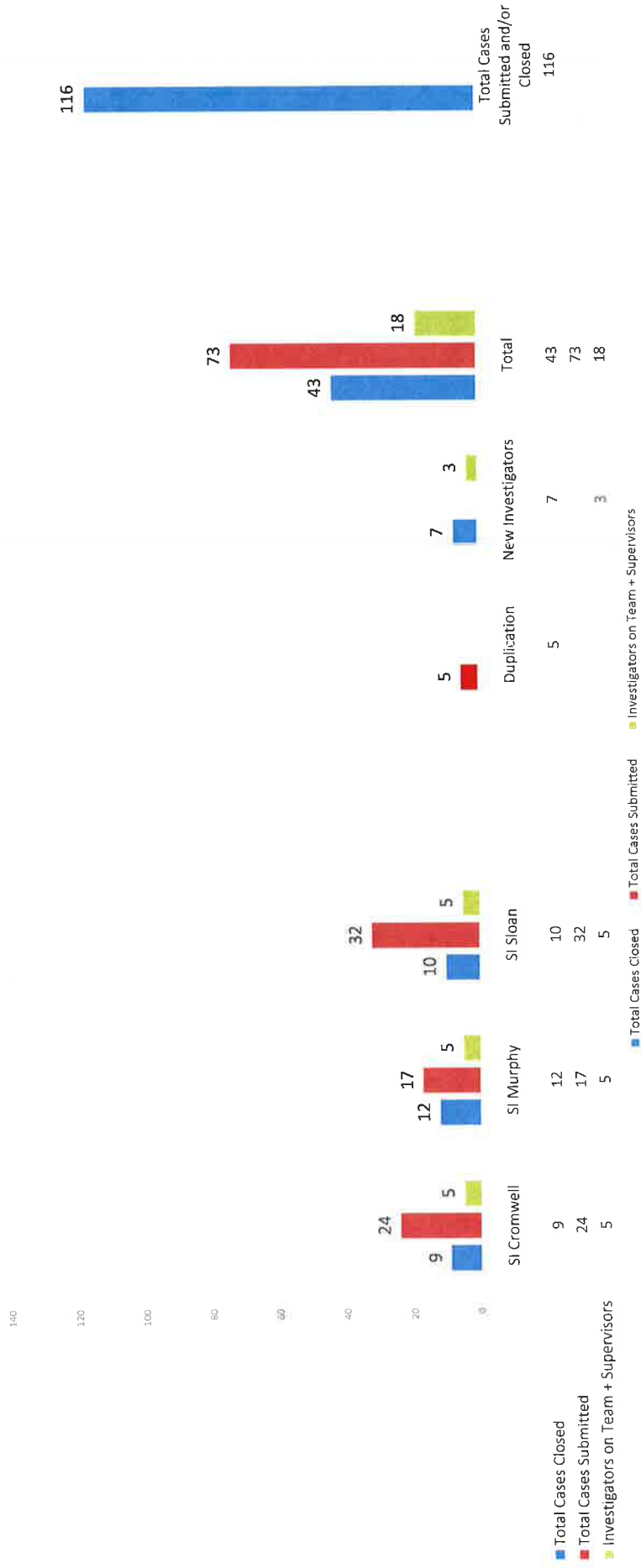


OCI INVESTIGATORS CLOSED 252 CASES JAN-MAR 2023

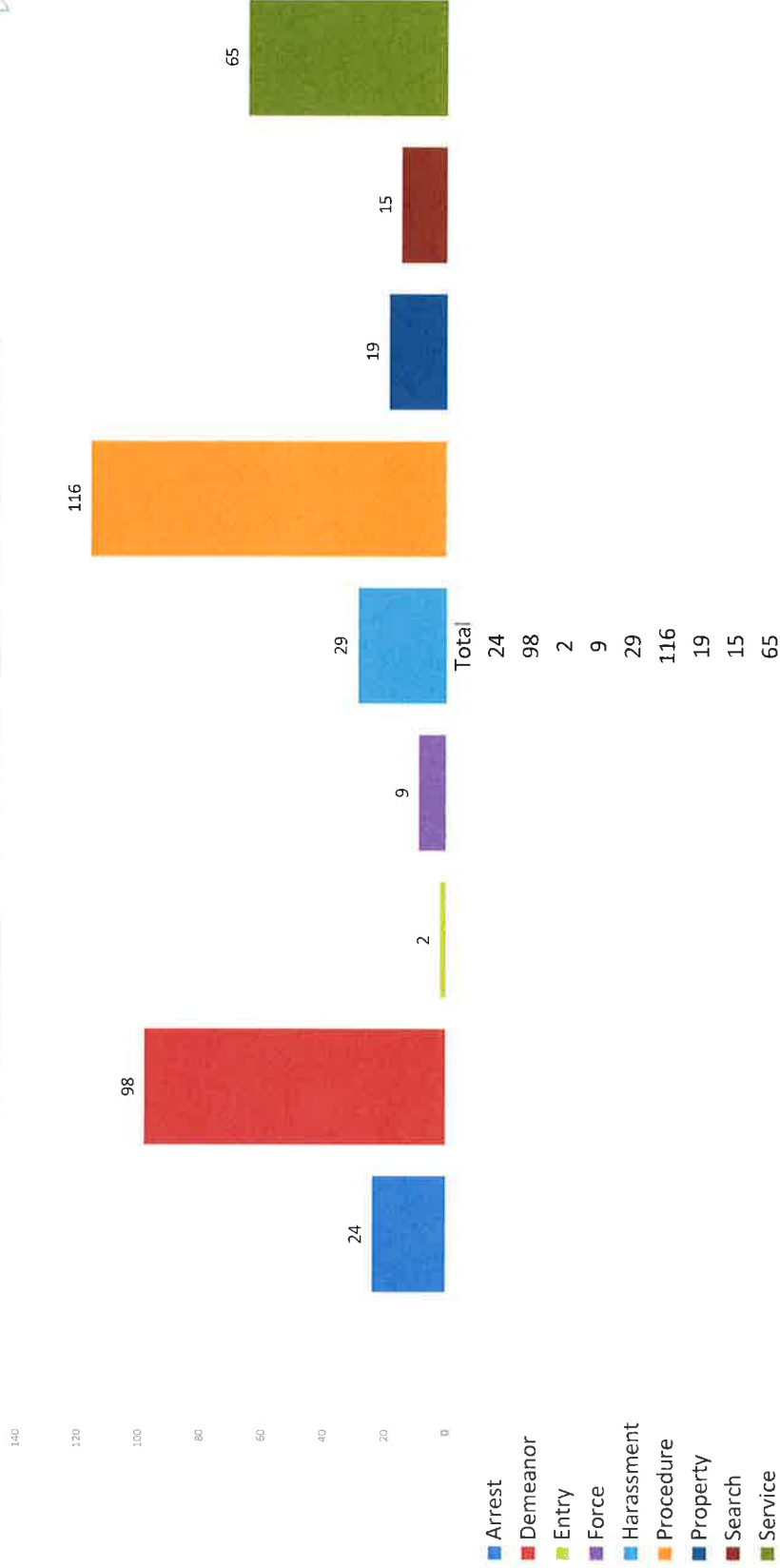




CASES CLOSED VS CASES SUBMITTED VS INVESTIGATORS ON TEAM – MARCH 2024

UNKNOWN COMMAND NUMBERS ARE GENERALLY HIGH AT CITIZEN COMPLAINT INTAKE. HOWEVER, THOSE COMMANDS ARE IDENTIFIED DURING THE COURSE OF THE OCI INVESTIGATION AND THE DATA IS UPDATED ACCORDINGLY.

THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT THE OFFICER IS UNKNOWN, JUST THAT THEIR ASSIGNMENT HAS NOT BEEN UPDATED IN THE MAS SYSTEM.

A CITIZEN COMPLAINT MAY HAVE SEVERAL ALLEGATIONS. EX: DEMEANOR, PROCEDURE, FORCE.
