Keep Your Home.



- If you own and occupy your home and do not owe taxes prior to 2012, you should seek a Distressed Owner Occupant Extension (DOOE) to have your home removed from tax foreclosure for 2015.
- If you own and occupy your home you should inquire about a SEVSPA or IRSPA (Interest Reduction Stipulated Payment Agreement) from the Wayne County Treasurer to lower your taxes and obtain an affordable payment plan.
- If you need help probating your home to obtain ownership, free help is available.
- If you are a tenant you may stay in your home after foreclosure on April
 1st and not be evicted.
- If you have a mortgage or land contract problems you should get help to resolve problems as well because they could still cost you your home even if you pay the taxes.
