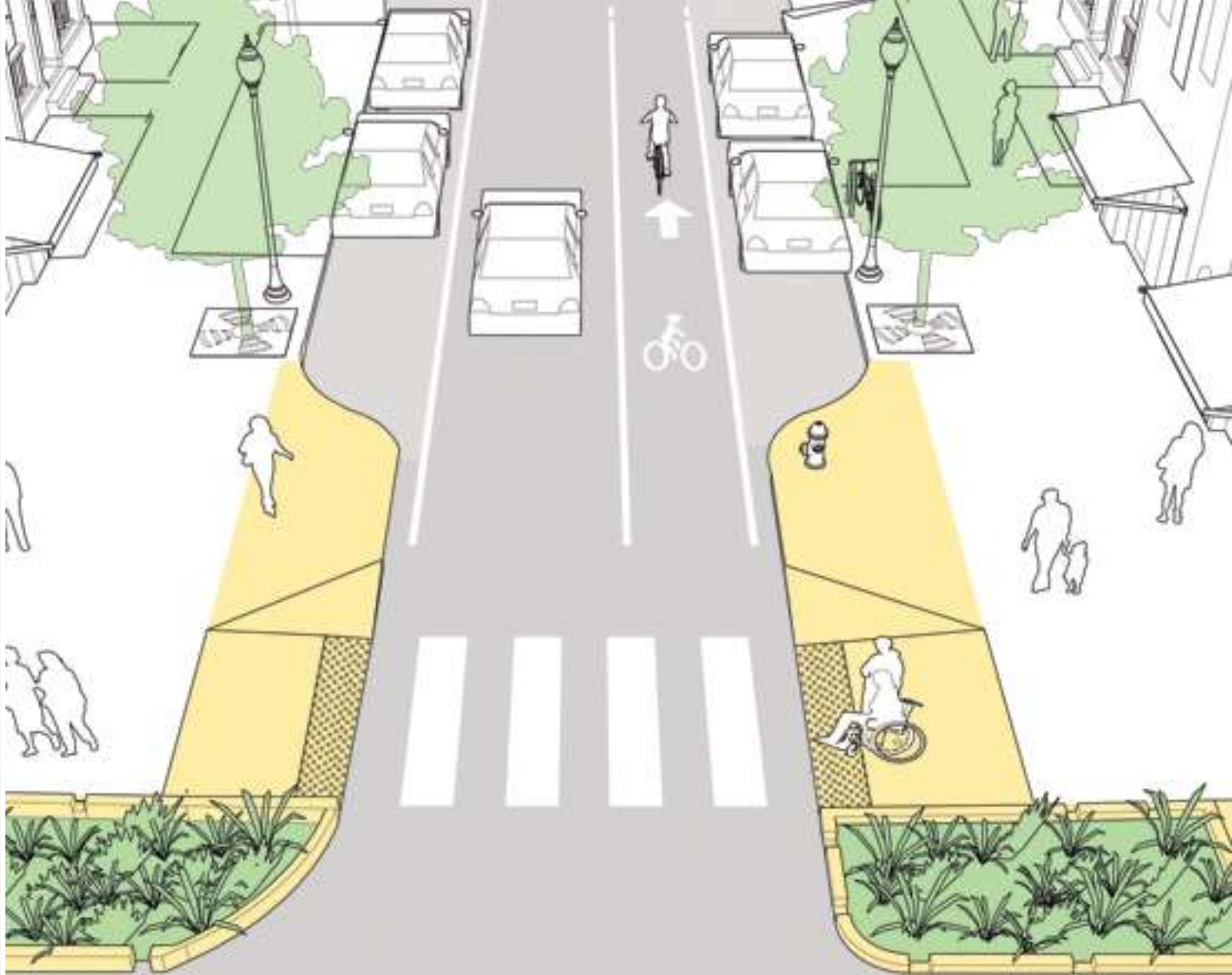

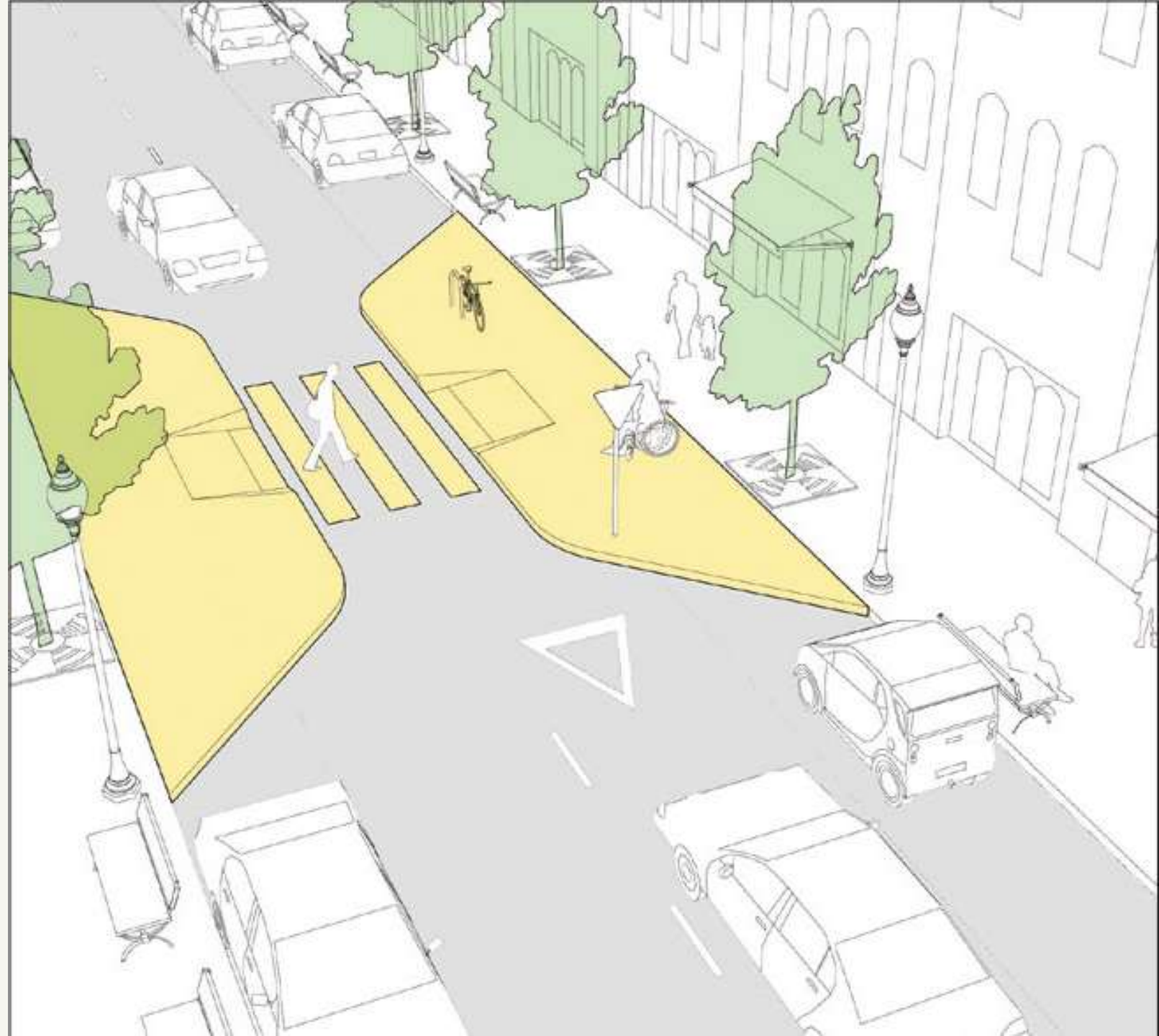

Opportunity for green space or community projects



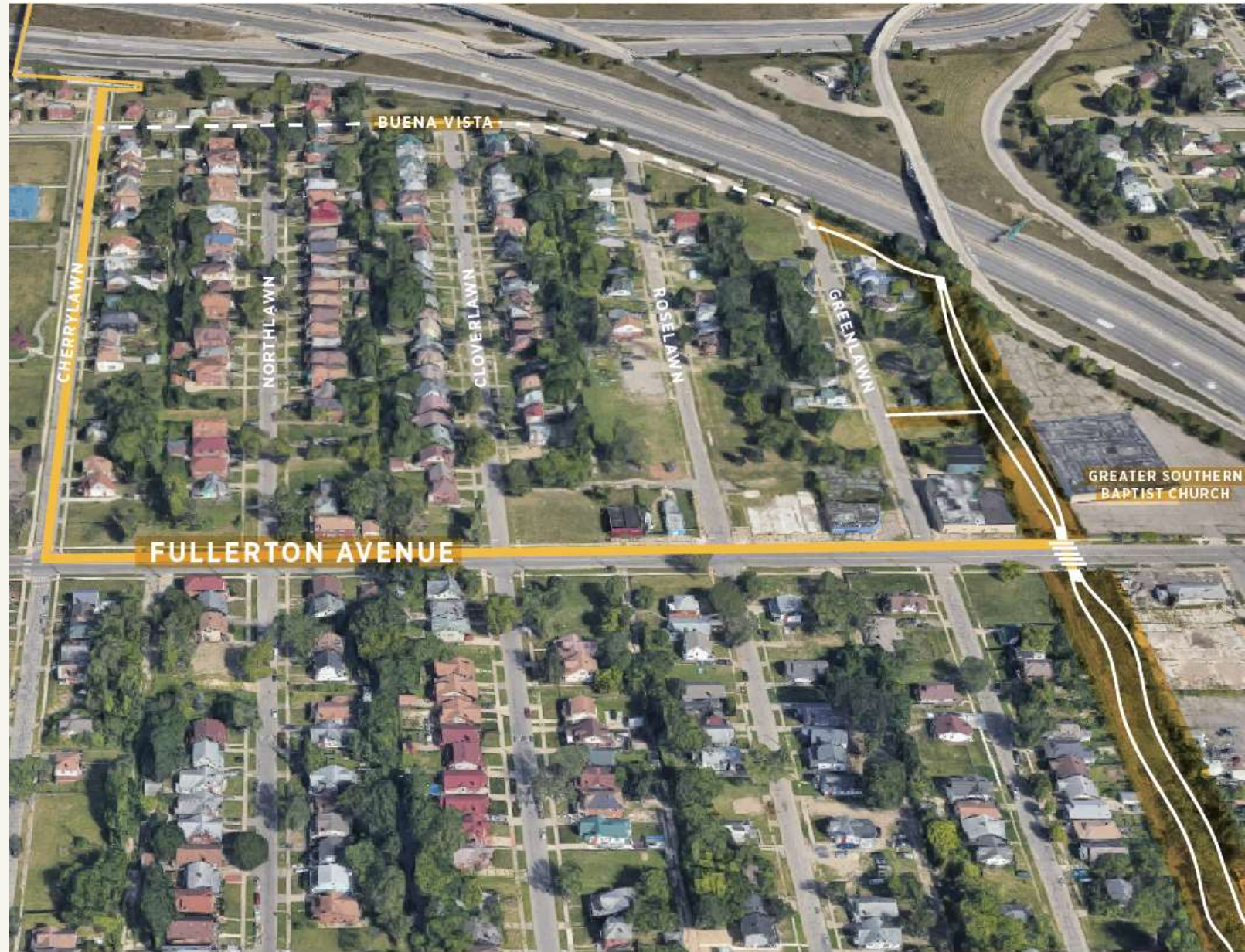


# BUENA VISTA

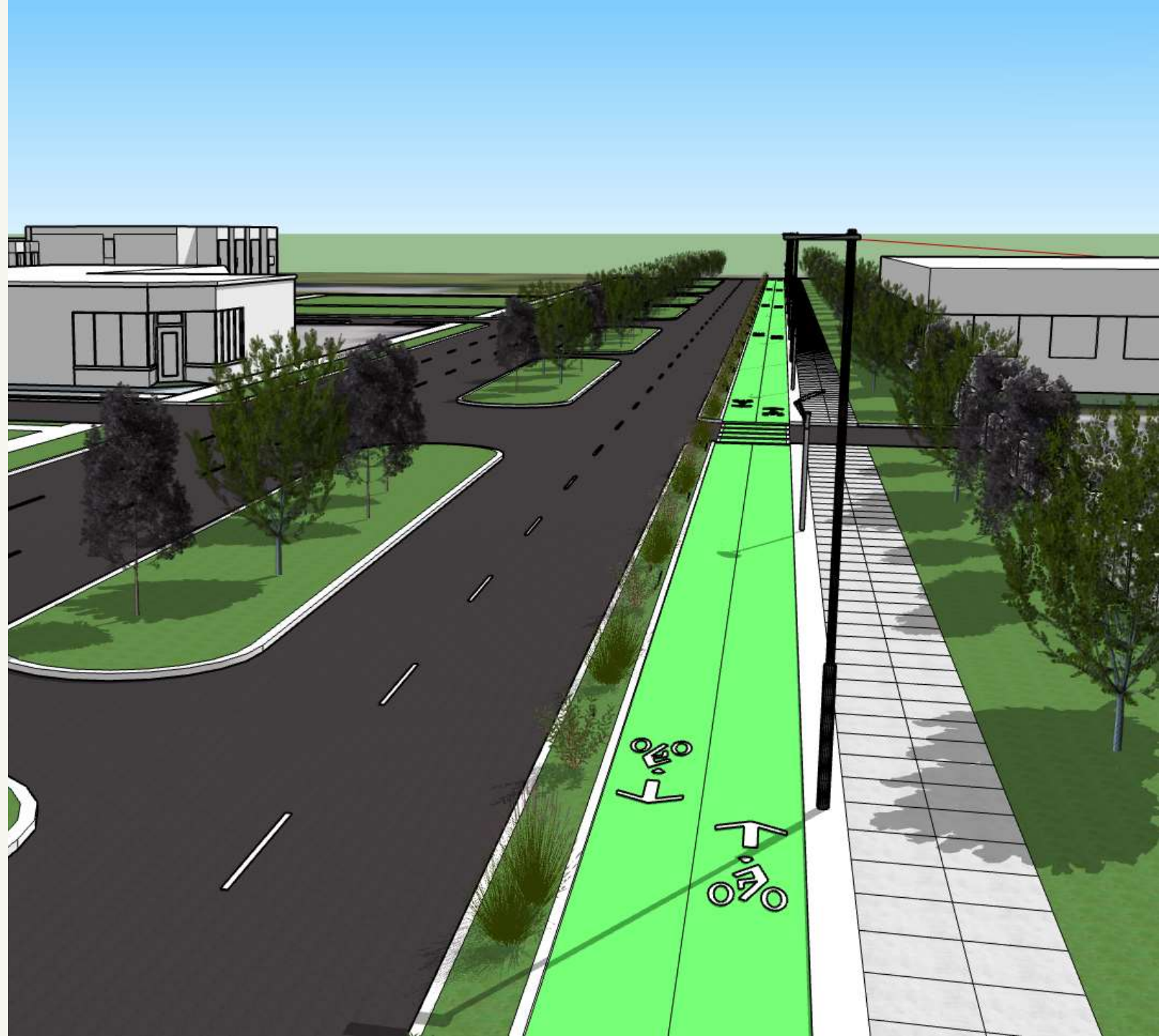
