EXISTING CONDITIONS

The building located at 1258 Washington Boulevard is an 8-story Renaissance Revival style office building constructed in 1901. The oldest building in the Washington Boulevard Historic District, the structure is clad in red brick with limestone and terra-cotta detailing. Additionally, it features varying window types and an ornate Italian Romanesque cornice. An Art Moderne style façade is featured on the lower levels of the building.

PROPOSAL

With the current proposal, the applicant is seeking the Commission's approval to install a new internally illuminated blade sign per the attached drawings and application. Sign materials and details include:

- Sign to be mounted onto the existing limestone façade at the northwest corner (intersection of Washington Boulevard and Grand River) of the building at a 45° angle with the bottom of the sign located 14' above grade.
- Sign to be circular in shape approximately 60" in diameter and 12" thick.

- Sign to be constructed of an aluminum frame (finish color: black) with 3/16" acrylic faces which will have full-color vinyl overlays displaying the Beer Exchange logo.
- Sign will be internally illuminated with LED modules.

STAFF OBSERVATIONS & RESEARCH

Washington Boulevard Historic District was designated in 2003.

ISSUES

- This blade sign was originally included in the application package for the general rehabilitation of the building that was heard by the Commission and approved on 11/14/2018, however, the sign was approved as *externally* illuminated. The applicant prefers an internally illuminated sign to match the signage at the Detroit Beer Exchange location in Kalamazoo (see photos in application materials). HDC staff does not have the authority to approve internally illuminated signage, therefore, the applicant chose to submit this modification as a new application to the Commission for review.
- The Kalamazoo Beer Exchange is not located in a local historic district of Kalamazoo, however, it is located in a historic building the Globe Building which was constructed in the early 1900s.
- The applicant provides photographs of other examples of internally illuminated blade signs on a nearby building within the Washington Boulevard HD in their application materials. Upon further review, it appears that the Starbucks sign was approved in 2017 and the Roast sign was approved in 2009. While it is evident that these types of internally illuminated "box" signs (metal frame with acrylic/vinyl planes) have been approved by the Commission previously, it is staff's opinion that the combination of material, illumination, and sign design of this type of box sign, is not compatible with the architectural features of the historic building, its site and setting.


RECOMMENDATION

It is staff's opinion that the combination of the material (acrylic/vinyl), design (metal frame with acrylic faces), and internal illumination is not compatible with the architectural features of the historic building and detracts from the historic integrity of the property. Staff therefore recommends that the Commission deny a Certificate of Appropriateness as the proposed work does not meet the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation, especially:


- #2) The historic character of a property shall be retained and preserved. The removal of historic materials or alteration of features and spaces that characterize a property shall be avoided.
- #9) New additions, exterior alterations, or related new construction shall not destroy historic materials that characterize the property. The new work shall be differentiated from the old and shall be compatible with the massing, size, scale, and architectural features to protect the historic integrity of the property and its environment.



Y1801 – Beer Exchange Detroit HDC Review 4 (Internally Lite Blade Sign)

- The following Scope of Work applies to the Detroit Beer Exchange as shown on the HDC Project Review Request form dated 7-21-2020.
- The proposed work is part of a new restaurant within the basement and first level of the existing Stevens Building on 1258 Washington Blvd.
- We propose installing an exterior blade sign (sign-c) on the North-West corner of the building.
 This sign will be internally illuminated, not externally illuminated. It will be attached to the existing building limestone panel façade. It will be made of acrylic faces with full color graphics.
- Sign-C is noted on our architectural drawings from the last HDC Review 3, dated 6-10-2020.
 Sign-C is also known as Blade Sign-A by Spectrum.
- Existing building conditions along with new sign, color and materials are noted on drawing and photos from the signage contractor, Spectrum Neon Signage. For added job description by the sign contractor refer Spectrum letter dated 7-27-2020.




The sign would be mounted at a 45 degree angle at the corner of Washington Blvd. & Grand River.
